I. General Information

A. Purpose

The purpose of this Request for Proposal is to plan for the Foundation Design and infrastructure of a water tank and filters for purifying the domestic water for Navajo Technical University (NTU) at the Chinle campus in Chinle, Az. NTU has a master plan that includes a 19 phase development, the development will happen over several years and the water tank must be able to support all future developments. All campus developments are also never finished with the University growing and many curriculum changes and adding new programs, therefore flexibility must also be considered and planned for.

The projected number of students attending the Chinle Campus is estimated at 1,500 to 3,000 potential students in the future once the full build out is completed. The location currently has two existing buildings that are now occupied and both buildings totaling 26,000 sq ft.

The University had recently added four additional modular units; these units are currently not occupied with plans of adding an additional 6 modular units and 10 mobile homes and 5 RV parking areas onto the property by May 2022 totaling an estimated average of 26,000 (+-) ft.².

In addition to the new modular units the University is projecting to develop additional facilities totaling an estimated average up to 250,000 ft.² within the next 5 to 6 years. The University also has plans for additional developments to include faculty/staff housing, dormitories and student housing and other development to make Chinle NTU a complete college branch campus with all amenities to position itself as a high quality educational campus.

The water tank and everything needed to supply water and meet the operations must be built with the extra capacity of future developments.

The successful bid must include:

- Review master plan to determine the size of tank for water storage
- Collaborate and work with NTUA for standards and requirements
- Plan for a Booster Pump and station
- Water service/ water flow pressure
- Fire Suppression
- Fire Hydrant
- Determine the best equipment, sizing, and height of the water tank
- Fire line
- Determine the ground elevation for tank
- Provide a complete detailed geotechnical investigation to understand the soil properties for the site location. This is important for the foundation of the water tank to resist any settlement and overturning.

The selected firm will be a nationally recognized company with extensive experience in designing and planning water tank systems for more than 5 projects in the commercial industry. The successful bidder will also provide documentation of a history of successful completed projects included in the bid.

One vendor per bid and the vendor must bid on all components. The term of the contract is at the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees of the College.

I. University Narrative and Background

Navajo Technical University is a tribal technical university established in 1979 and chartered by the Navajo Nation. The main campus of the University is located in Crownpoint in Northwest New Mexico with an instructional branch in Chinle, Arizona. The design project referenced in this proposal will be located at the Chinle, Arizona site. The University prepares Navajos and other students with a quality technical and vocational education, associate degrees, baccalaureate degrees, graduate degrees, certificates, or community education in a higher learning setting. With a current enrollment of roughly 1,400 students at the main campus and at its satellite sites in Chinle and Teec Nos Pos, Arizona and Kirtland, Church Rock, and Zuni, New Mexico, the University is in a unique position to transition students directly into the workforce; it addresses the higher education needs of the Navajo Nation in an immediate and comprehensive manner. Navajo Technical University is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission (HLC) and is a member of the American Indian Higher Education Consortium (AIHEC).

II. Scope of Services

The Scope of Work/Services is as follows:

1) Design and infrastructure of a water tank and filters for purifying the domestic water with capability of future expansion

- 2) A schematic design pipeline to distribution to include pipeline alignments, utility infrastructure and building components.
- 3) The selected firm will be required to cooperate and coordinate with NTUA and/or other consultants by NTUA or NTU. The design will be reviewed by NTUA
- 4) The selected firm will be required to cooperate and coordinate with NTU owner's representative and team
- 5) Develop a comprehensive plan for water and wastewater
- 6) Booster Pump and Station
- 7) Water storage facility to be determine by the comprehensive study
- 8) Record drawings
- 9) Fire Suppression
- 10) Fire Hydrant
- 11) Determine the ground elevation for tank
- 12) Provide a complete detailed geotechnical investigation to understand the soil properties for the site location. This is important for the foundation of the water tank to resist any settlement and overturning.
- 13) Provide and complete a topographical survey and site layout, if needed. Must review the existing master plan prior to any additional surveys beforehand.
- 14) Perform an engineering analysis to prepare preliminary and final design, design report, drawings and specifications and must provide a cost estimation, construction schedule, and provide all documents using the design guidelines and criteria from regulatory agencies to meet the standards, regulations, permits, codes to NTUA and the Navajo Nation Environmental Protection Agency.
- 15) Perform a Mechanical and structural analysis to ensure the project will meet and support the maximum loads
- 16) Water tank is to be tied in with existing water system and to pressurize water flow to all existing and future buildings

III. Proposal Requirements

- 3. Demonstrate and share previous experience with projects of this scope within the past 5 years
- 4. Proposal must include a minimum of five (5) references including contact name, position title, address, phone number for all individuals who are knowledgeable of the quality of the engineering design of the bidder.
- 5. The bidder must also show evidence of expertise with the use of BIM and must provide information and documentation of how the bidder incorporated this method with other projects
